Project Overview:	A full modernization to address facility deficiencies and end of life components identified. LTIS was built in 1966. A modernization would improve the environment ensuring the continued health and safety of students as well as faculty. The ongoing maintenance of the facility in the current condition is lending to high ongoing operating costs. Portions of the storm lines have been replaced and the South portion still requires repalcement. Parking lot paving, roof hvac units, and boilers have been replaced. Programming requirements will need to be reviewed at the time of modernization.

Project Name:	Smith School Modernization		
Project Type	Modernization and Rightsizing		
Project Priority	Medium		
Project Overview:	A full modernization including rightsizing the school and addressing deficiencies. Smith School was built in 1953 and is 2378.53 sq. meters. Rightsizing the building with the removal of the original 1953 section of the building would decrease size by 490 sq. meters. A modernization would reduce the ongoing maintenance costs by revitalizing the existing facility increasing energy efficiency, and reducing maintenance costs. Substantial repairs are required including the repair of foundation walls and repair concrete slab in the maintenance room, replacement of roofing, stucco, parging, windows and doors, and concrete stairs. The modernization would include a new library which would lend to community partnerships.		
Criteria	Health and Safety	1966, 1967 and 1970 areas are all unsprinklered. Basement leaks annually during the Spring and Summer months, and is quite damp. Electrical upgrade due.

Project Overview: A full modernization to address deficiencies identified, and rightsizing the school. The original school was built in 1957. Multiple roof structures require replacement and interior and exterior finishes such as flooring and soffits/fascia, mechanical, electrical service upgrade, windows and doors. The Utilization report indicates that it is 21% utilized. Rightsizing would reduce ongoing operational costs including utilities, maintenance, and custodial.
